



WARRIOR KIDS CAN BLOG TOO!

In this activity, Warrior Kids create their own blog to post online!

STEP 1

Think about something important that you care very deeply about – it could be anything! You can use our previous Warrior Kids Podcast episodes for inspiration and write about turtles, trees or families - or you can think of something totally new.

STEP 2

Think about why you care about this topic and why you think this topic is important for other people to learn more about. Jot down some of these ideas.

STEP 3

Now that you know your general topic, and why it is important to you, think about one or two things that other people could do to help take action on your topic. If you care about protecting bees, then what steps can people

take to help protect bees? You might need to do some research to help inform your blog. Don't forget to our Warrior Kids Podcast episodes as part of your research!

Step 4

Now it's time to decide what kind of blog you will create. Will it be a written blog or an artistic blog or both?

If it is a written blog, here is a general guide for how to write it:

- Title;
- Who you are and your background;
- What is the issue you care about and why;
- What will happen if people don't take action;
- What can we do to take action on your issue;
- Decide also if you are including artwork with your blog; and
- Don't forget to put only your first name, country and age.

If it is an artistic blog, here are some considerations:

- Title
- Will you draw, paint or craft or take pictures;
- If your art is one item, like a drawing, then think about everything that needs to appear in your picture to convey the topic, why it's important and how to take action;
- If your art will be more than one picture, then about how each picture will represent each part of your blog;
- Don't forget to put only your first name, country and age on the picture.

Once you are done, check it over for any spelling errors or artistic changes you want to make and then you can hang it up on your wall or submit it to us!
